- ▶ The focus is on peer-learning and interaction with each other.

MANAGEMENT AND MENTORING

- Each session is facilitated by Crescents of Brisbane Team Members, many of whom have formal IT skills
- In addition to Dr. Mustafa Ally's role as coordinator of this initiative, Lead Mentors will take on the responsibility of running the session.

TYPICAL SESSION FORMAT

- PERIOD: 6 Week block
- DAYS: Saturdays
- SESSION DURATION: 2 hours

FAQs (1)

What experience do I need to have to attend a CoderDojo session?

- > You simply need to be able to browse the internet.
- The whole point is to introduce our young participants to programming and inspire them to explore on their own and with other like-minded kids.

What will I do at CoderDojo Crescents of Brisbane?

- If you have an interest in how websites, games and other computer programs work, you'll be guided in how to create your own.
- One of the CoderDojo principles is to let the participants lead the learning rather than the sessions being like a classroom.

I have had a bit of a play with coding. Will this be too advanced or too basic for me?

Eventually CoderDojo sessions will be led by what the participants are interested in, and are flexible enough to break out into various groups based on interests and ability..

FAQs (2)

Do I have to bring my own laptop/tablet?

- If you have one, and are comfortable using it, please bring it along.
- There will be PCs available for others.

Do I have to register?

- Yes, spaces are limited.
- Registrations will only be accepted for the maximum limit.

What are the costs for attending?

- There is no cost for children to participate in the CoderDojo Crescents of Brisbane program.
- The Crescents of Brisbane team will cover the costs of materials etc. through the generosity of businesses and supporters in the future, insha'Allah

Are parents allowed to attend?

- We absolutely welcome and encourage parents with coding experience to get involved as Mentors
- There will be plenty of space for you to sit with your child to help them problem solve or just provide encouragement.
- It's really no different to attending your child's sporting games.
- Don't know anything about computers or coding, and not sure how you will be able to help your child in the CoderDojo session and at home?
 - Don't we all feel a bit left behind in this accelerating world.
 - Don't worry. Research has shown that encouragement is the best motivator for child led learning.
 - Many of our parents don't know the clicky end of a mouse but their children are excelling through pure encouragement from the parent.
 - Just be ready to be amazed by your children.
