Brisbane City Council, Employment Services is starting a new project called the Employment Pathways Coordinator. This project is developed in partnership between Council and Department of Employment and Industrial Relation under the “*Skilling Queenslanders For Work*” initiative (previously called Community Jobs Plan - CJP)

Employment Pathways Coordinator project will employ six participants from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and train them to become Multicultural Employment Advisors. The participants will be placed in relevant Council sections to gain practical knowledge of recruitment and selection process.
