We are sure that you will enjoy a number of very exciting fixtures that are on today's program from the many number of exciting players from the 24 participating nations.

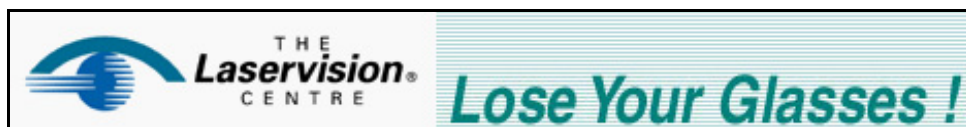
