Help establish the first Masjid in Toowoomba, Queensland, Australia

Place of worship

Muslims are living in Toowoomba for over two decades without any Mosque. Due to significant growth of Muslim population in the city the community has been trying to setup a Mosque for the last 2-3 years. The task has been particularly difficult because of very strict council regulations for a place of worship. Recently the property at 217-221 West St (corner of Stephan St) Toowoomba Australia with a church, came to the market for sale. It is located about 5km from the University of Southern Queensland (USQ), less than 1km from Toowoomba hospital and within 2km from the city centre. The total land size of the property is 2765sqm. The price is AUD\$900,000 (AUD\$1 = USD\$1.03), on top we will need to pay 10% GST and about \$40k stamp duty. The existing church fits our current needs for the first Mosque in Toowoomba. We believe this is a rare opportunity, and we could not afford to miss it.

Toowoomba - The Garden City

Toowoomba, the Garden City of Australia, is 1.5 hour driving distance from Brisbane, capital of Queensland, Australia. The population of the city is around 150,000 of which over 1000 are Muslims. There has been a 20% growth of Muslims in the city in the recent 2012 census. There is no Mosque in Toowoomba or Lockyer Valley and Darling Downs regions.

The nearest Mosque is in Brisbane. Currently, all Muslims in the city/region worship in a temporary facility provided by the University of Southern Queensland (USQ) which no longer meets the current and future needs. So the Islamic Society of Toowoomba Inc, a Government registered non-profit Islamic organisation, has decided to purchase the property to meet the growing need of a Mosque in the city, and has initiated a major fundraising at home and abroad.



Muslims in Toowoomba

The Muslim Community in Toowoomba is united under the banner of the Islamic Society of Toowoomba (IST) Inc. It is a registered non-profit organization to serve the needs of Islamic practices of the Muslims in Toowoomba and its surroundings. Many Muslim settlers and students at the University of Southern Queensland (USQ), prior to their arrival, contact IST to enquire about facilities for Islamic practices. The IST is a member of the Islamic Council of Queensland (ICQ), a forum of the Muslims in the state of Queensland in Australia. The ICQ is a part of the Federation of the Islamic Councils in Australia (AFIC), an umbrella organization of the Muslims of Australia.

The University of Southern Queensland has provided an Islamic Centre on its Toowoomba campus for its Muslim students and staff. The Centre is run by the IST, and uses it for all the religious needs of the local Muslims. This Centre has a prayer area as well as separate toilets and ablution areas for male and female users. The USQ deserves unqualified thanks and gratitude for its support towards its Muslim population. However it is time for the Muslims to have a Mosque of their own to meet their religious obligations.

The IST manages the regular daily prayers, Friday congregational prayer, tarawi prayers in Ramadhan, and celebration of Eid prayers. It also organizes regular community meetings and dinners. The program includes sharing of varieties food, discussion on Islamic and Community issues and lessons from the Holy Qur'an. The IST also organizes community picnics, raises funds to help distressed people around the world as well as collects and distributes Zakat and Fitr as per Islamic practices. It also runs Quar'an teaching classes for children.

Property Details

The property at 217-221 West St (corner of Stephan St, as marked red on the map below), Toowoomba, Australia has two churches (photos below) and another old building. There are three separate entrances to the property with 800sqm of vacant land for parking. The larger church building fits our current needs for a Mosque in Toowoomba. It is a rare opportunity that must not be missed.


Position: This property is located approx 2km South West of Toowoombas CBD. It is also near the Toowoomba Base Hospital and on route to the University of Southern Queensland.

Buildings: (1) A stylish brick Chapel

Built in the 1960's. The building is almost 270sqm of which there is covered entry, foyer, childrens crying room and main auditorium. In addition, there is an area of approx 40sqm at the rear which is used as an office, reception, toilet and storage. Contruction is of brick walls, timber frame and tiled roof except for the rear office which has a klip-loc skillion roof.

Buildings: (2) Original Church and Hall

The old church dates back to around 1910. A lovely building of approximately 100sqm including original entry and kitchen. Contruction of weatherboard and chamferboard walls on timber floor and posts. The roof is of a steep pitch design (corrugated galvanised iron) which adds to the character of the building. Internal wall cladding is mainly VJ pine and balance fibro cement sheeting. The adjoining hall is thought to have been constructed in the 1960's. This building has an area of approx 190sqm including 20sqm of male and female toilets. The external walls are weatherboard and hardiplank and the roof is corrugated galvanized iron. Internal partitions are VJ pine and fibro cement. There is also provision for storage rooms and additional toilets.
