David's involvement in community includes;

- 7. David was and still is to some extent an active member of the Queensland branch of Amnesty International
- 8. Senior Vice President of the Sunnybank RSL, David has helped the Islamic College of Brisbane with the ANZAC Day commemorations at the school ensuring that detractors are silenced when it comes to the empathising with the Anzacs
- 9. He is on the board of Australian Palestinian Advocacy Network.
- 10. He has helped and continues to help the Rohingya community to articulate the story of the condition of their families and friends back home

These represent only some of David's activities...

But... We are here to acknowledge David's tireless and extensive contribution to the Muslim community spanning at least the many years we know him.

His efforts in relation to the community are too numerous to mention. But the constant vigilance he displays in order to ensure our community doesn't suffer harm must be commended and applauded.

He goes above and beyond the requisites of his job as Senior Policy Advisor in the Queensland Government's Department of Multicultural Affairs.

In his professional and private capacity he has come to the defence of the Muslim community when we've been misrepresented, unfairly portrayed or maligned in the media and other social forums.

His valiant yet unsuccessful attempts at getting into Parliament to defend justice for all are not to be forgotten. However, David is probably most noted for his sincere, passionate and brazenly outspoken support of the Palestinian cause. Something very dear to our hearts. His relentless determination, unyielding single-mindedness and dogged insistence on pursuing something, Not much of what we mentioned would have taken place. He has fought many causes on our behalf and continues to do so.

As an idealist, I used to think it unnecessary to thank those who stand up for justice, simply because in my view, it was the honourable and expected thing to do. That was until I heard the hadith of the Prophet SAW when he said

"One who does not thank people does not thank Allah"

The operative word being People and not Muslims only.

Hajji Ebrahim Patel was indeed a pioneer in assisting our local community settle into this country comfortably and maintain their ideals. We think you embody this ethos.
