Work readiness program – Engineering

Ai Group has secured funding from the Department of Employment and Industrial Relations to support the State Government's "*Skilling Queenslanders for Work*" initiative to run a tailored program fully funded for eligible participants willing to undertake training and secure employment in the manufacturing industry.

The 6 week engineering course will commence on 26th May 2008 and complete on the 4th July 2008 (this includes work experience). The work readiness program will be delivered at The Bremer Institute of TAFE Bundamba Campus.

The units of competency that will be delivered over the 6 week period including work experience are:

- Manual Heating & Thermal cutting
- Perform Routine gas metal Welding
- Arc or Gas metal arc welding
- Use Hand Tools
- Use Power Tools
- Perform engineering measurements
- Carry out Mechanical cutting
- Use work machine for basic operations

This assistance is aimed at applicants within the target groups listed below:

- Unemployed 17 29 year olds
- Unemployed adults over 30 years of age
- Adults over 40 years of age
- Long term unemployed
- Migrants and refugees from a non English speaking background
- Woman into non traditional trades
- Underemployed existing workers who are employed less than 20 hours/ week

Participants will be provided with safety boots, safety glasses and clothing
