Nomination Information

The Young Australian Muslim of the Year (YAMY) award aims to support, recognise and encourage Outstanding Contributions to the Community in Muslim youth and to encourage increased participation to the Australian community. The YAMY award is unique in that it places the emphasis an individual's ability to contribute their skills, talent and time to the community, as opposed to recognising the individual for the skill or talent alone. We hope that by celebrating community service oriented achievements will encourage more young people to contribute, raise the profile of volunteering and charity work and increase a sense of communal self esteem. Parents and community leaders alike were amazed and inspired to hear the contributions of young people to the community at the previous YAMY award ceremony.

Nominees will be judged on specific criteria. (See below). We encourage all members of the Australian community to recognise the contributions of Australian Muslim young people by nominating them for the 2007 YAMY award.

The YAMY project is brought to you by the YAMY team - A team of amazing & altruistic young Australian Muslims who see it as their responsibility to contribute to the community and have fun at the same time.

The YAMY award is managed by the Islamic Council of Victoria and is generously supported by the Department of Immigration & Citizenship.

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

- 1. Please do not nominate the same person more than once. It is not like Australian Idol.
- 2. Nominations are to be based on the selection criteria.
- 3. Please ensure the quality of the nomination form does justice to the young person being nominated by providing adequate information and supporting documentation of the young person's community service efforts.
- 4. The YAMY award does not recognise academic or sporting achievement, except where the academic or sporting achievement have been used to directly benefit another person, or by being a role model.
- 5. Please attach supporting documentation with your nomination form. This can include, for example, personal references, portfolios of work related to the award, photographs, samples of work and testimonials from different people about the nominee.
- 6. Nominees must be aged between 15-19 (Year 10 to Year 12)
- 7. The award is retrospective; therefore if a student was in Year 12 in 2006 they are eligible for the award and can be nominated in 2007
- 8. Nominations close Friday March 30th 5:00pm, 2007
- 9. Winners announced at the YAMY award ceremony Saturday April 21^{st,} 2007. (Venue to be confirmed)

Selection Criteria

- ✓ Has made a significant contribution to the community (Core)
- ✓ Is an Inspirational role model for young people (Core)
- ✓ Acknowledges Australian Muslim Identity (Core)
- ✓ Demonstrates a generous spirit and Islamic character (Core)
- ✓ Shares their resources, skills, experience and time with other people (Core)
- ✓ Commits to worthy causes through volunteer work (Additional)
- ✓ Demonstrates support for other people or causes (Additional)
- ✓ Engages in dialogue with people of diverse faiths and backgrounds (Additional)
- ✓ Participates in community / school events, camps & Islamic classes (Additional)

Nominations

Individuals can nominate young people that are between year 10 to 12 from January to March 30th, 2007.

Tips: Successful nominations are those that address how the student has contributed according to the selection criteria. Students that are nominated must demonstrate excellence in at least 3 CORE selection criteria requirements and 1 ADDITIONAL selection criteria. Please Note: Winners will be selected based on their performance in the <u>selection criteria</u>, rather than the number of times they are nominated. So please do not send in more than 1 nomination form per student.

Nominations Close:

Nomination forms must be received at ICV by 5:00pm Friday 30th March. Nominations received after this date will not be included.
