Young Volunteer Awards

Young people are essential to volunteering in Queensland. Young volunteers contribute to our communities in many different ways. From sports and the arts, to health care, to emergency services, to social welfare and the environment, young volunteers play an active role in every aspect of civil society and community life.

In recognition of the positive difference young volunteers make to our state, the Queensland Government has established the Queensland Young Volunteer Awards to acknowledge young volunteers, aged between 12 and 25 years, with a \$2,000 cash prize.

We encourage community leaders and organisations throughout Queensland to nominate a young person or group of young people they believe should be recognised with a Queensland Young Volunteer Award.

The awards

Eight awards, each including a \$2,000 cash prize, will be presented at a special award ceremony held in Brisbane during National Youth Week in April 2007. The awards include categories for individuals and groups.

Young volunteers should be nominated by a recognised community leader or community organisation.

Nominee information

Nominees should be currently involved in volunteer work in Queensland and aged between 12 and 25 years.

A selection committee will consist of representatives from youth organisations, Volunteering Queensland and the Department of Communities. The committee will select award winners by assessing each nomination against the above criteria and the authenticity of the winning submissions will be verified. The selection committee's decision on the Queensland Young Volunteer Awards winners is final.
