The Nuhovic Family wish to thank all those generous people who have helped them raise the funds for the purchase of the eye gaze machine and the cost of the speech therapist to train Dznean in utilizing the device. Words cannot express how the family feel about the outcome of the help given by so many people who have assisted in some way. It was not only the money that mattered, but the fact that they were not alone in their quest to ensure their son has some quality of life, even if he is a quadriplegic. His physical attendance at the International Women's Day, with so many people greeting him, and his enjoyment of the event, boosted his emotional state and drew attention to the fact that he is still a social person and needs the company of people in his own age group. He also needs the stimulus of some type of young entertainment. Dznean still has his sight and hearing, even though he no control over any other part of his body.

Disability Servivces has now recommended that a support group be established for Dznean and a separate one for the parents, so they may have some time for themselves. Janeth Deen is one of the support network who will be organising people to fill these needs. She attended a session at Disability Services last Monday. MCF must be acknowledged for this generous offer. MCF could not pay for the entire machine as it had so many other cases to help.
