



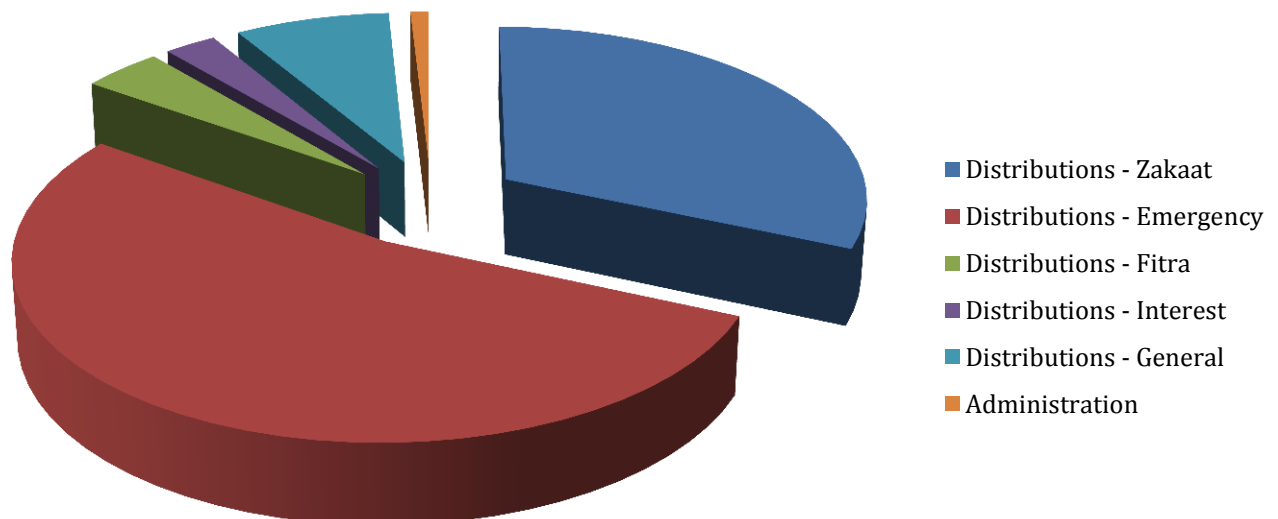
Treasurer's Report:

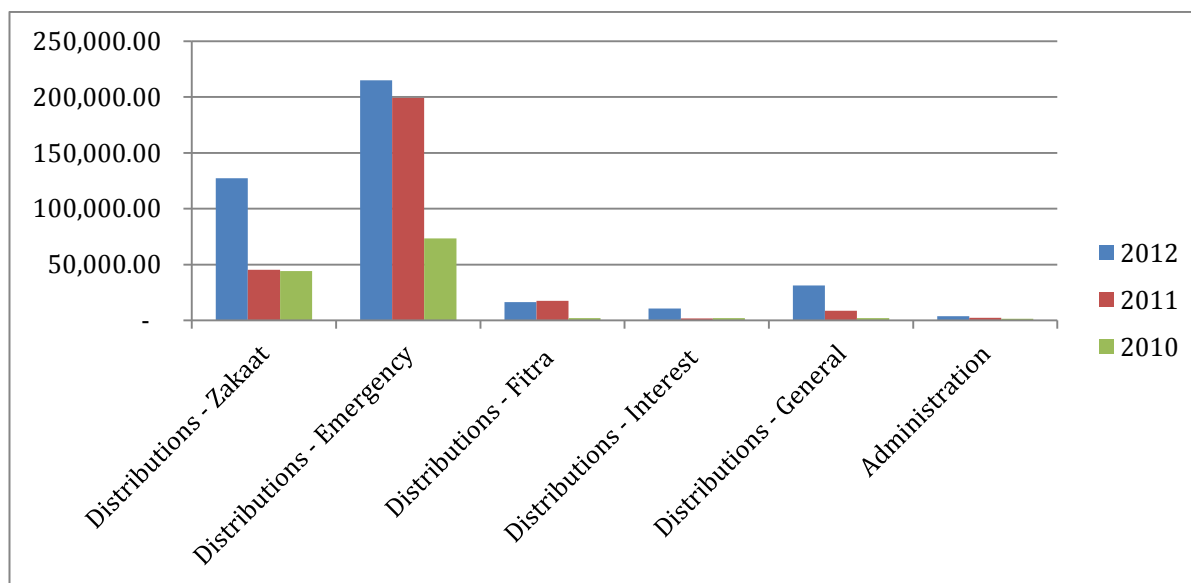
