Currently, all Muslims in the city/region worship in a temporary facility provided by the USQ which is old and inadequate to meet the current and future needs.

The Islamic Society of Toowoomba Inc has decided to purchase a church property to meet the growing need of a Masjid in the city, and has initiated a major fundraising campaogn at home and abroad.

The Society needs AUD\$925,000 to purchase the property and add essenatial features and facilities suitable for a Masjid. We urge everyone to pray to Allah for the acceptance of the project and help establish the first Masjid in the city. We count on your ongoing support.
