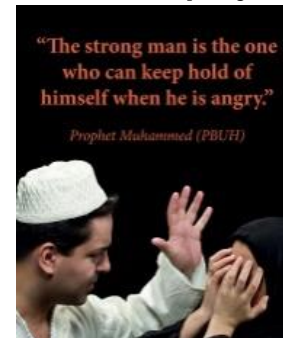

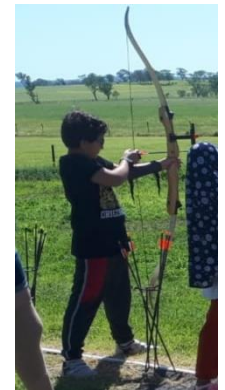
Shrove Tuesday / Pancake Day 25th February 2020
