

NOTICE: ISLAMIC SOCIETY OF ALGESTER REOPENING

The Islamic society of algester would like to announce the reopening of the Masjid for a maximum of 200 people for the five daily prayers as per advice provided for places of worship in accordance with Queensland's COVID Safe Plan.

In addition to the limit of 200 people, the following measures must be followed to be in compliance with the COVID Safe Plan:

- Sign in through the paper tracking register upon entry and exit of the masjid for COVID tracing purposes or register using this form;
- Use hand sanitizer on entry of the masjid;
- Wudhu must be made at home prior to coming to the masjid;
- The 4sqm social distancing between Musalli must be adhered when on the premises;
- Once you have completed praying Salah, please exit the masjid, and do not linger and socialise;
- Anyone who is feeling ill, please do not come to the masjid for the safety of your fellow Muslims;
- It is recommended that the elderly, people with existing health conditions remain at home for their own health and safety; and
- It is also recommended to bring your own prayer mat for every prayer.

In addition to the above measures, we ask that everyone downloads the COVIDSafe App as it has been recommended by the Government.
