



The Queensland Program of Assistance to Survivors of Torture and Trauma (QPASTT) is a non-government organisation providing a range of services to refugees, especially survivors of torture and trauma. These include counselling and clinical services, specialist children's and youth programs, community development work, research and innovation.

QPASTT has two 12-month maternity leave locum positions (commencing early November 2008) for:

- Counsellor/Advocate Youth Team
- Capacity Building and Support Worker (Children's Program)

Counsellor/Advocates are responsible for the provision of counselling and advocacy casework services for survivors of torture and trauma, with a particular emphasis on youth counselling and suicide prevention work. Relevant counselling qualifications are essential and may include social work, psychology, behavioural science or equivalent. This position can be filled on either a part time or full time basis.

Capacity Building and Support Worker - is responsible for working with primary schools to build their capacity to support students from refugee backgrounds and for developing group based support programs for refugee children, their families and school communities.
