JOB REQUIREMENTS

1. You should have a strong connection to the Logan community. You may:
 - be a Logan resident,
 - have worked in the area for a period of time, or
 - be involved in a community group in the area.
2. You have not participated in any traineeship / apprenticeship in the past, or in accredited TAFE training.
3. You are a:
 - citizen of Australia or New Zealand, or
 - holder of a permanent residency or temporary protection visa, or
 - holder of a temporary residency visa and engaged or married to an Australian citizen.
4. You belong to one of the following groups:
 - aged between 15 and 24, (if you are under 18, a parent or guardian must support your application and sign your training contract),
 - women re-entering the workforce.
